- \underline{X} To be followed by $\underline{3}$ years on Count One of supervised release, and 1 year on Count Two to run concurrent with Count One of the Information.
- \underline{X} Special conditions of supervised release are as follows: $\underline{1}$. The defendant shall not possess a firearm, ammunition, or destructive device.
