ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE WHY CASE OUGHT NOT BE DISMISSED FOR FAILURE TO FILE RULE 1007 LISTS, SCHEDULES, OR STATEMENTS

The debtor(s) having failed to comply with the court's previously–entered order directing the debtor(s) to file any unfiled papers required by F.R. Bankr. P. 1007 within 15 days after the filing of the petition, it is

ORDERED that by a writing filed within 14 days of entry of this order, the debtor(s) shall show cause, if any the debtor(s) has, why the case ought not be dismissed with prejudice for 180 days for failure to comply with the order previously entered by the court. It is further

ORDERED that by a writing filed within 14 days of entry of this order, the trustee and the U.S. Trustee, shall show cause, if either such party asserts that such cause exists, why this case ought not be dismissed with prejudice for a period of 180 days pursuant to 11 U.S.C. Section 109(g).
