ORDERED, that the Motion be, and hereby is, granted, and the following

compromise between Kevin R. McCarthy, the Trustee, and Uwe Siemon-Netto and

Gillian Siemon-Netto, the Debtors, is approved:

- 1) The Debtors will pay the Trustee \$25,000.00 on before August 18, 2006.
- 2) Except as provided in No. 3 below, such payment will be in full and final satisfaction of all claims by the Trustee or the bankruptcy estate against the Debtors or their non-exempt property, the Debtors will have no claims against the Trustee or the

bankruptcy estate (including any right to claim an exemption in such payment), and all non-exempt property of the Debtors except for such payment and any interest thereon will be deemed abandoned to the Debtors.

3. The Debtors' painting entitled "Con Anima" by Schifano that is being sold by the Trustee pursuant to separate Order of the Court and all sale proceeds and any interest thereon also will be property of the bankruptcy estate free and clear of any claims by the Debtors (including any right to claim an exemption), and will not be deemed abandoned to the Debtors.
