AND NOW, this 12<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2002, IT IS HEREBY  
ORDERED that:

(1) the motion of The Society of Lloyd's for summary judgment under the Pennsylvania Uniform Foreign Money Judgment Recognition Act, 42 Pa. Cons. Stat. Ann. § 22001, et seq. is GRANTED. See Society of Lloyd's v. Ashenden, 233 F.3d 473 (7th Cir. 2000); Society of Lloyd's v. Webb, 156 F. Supp. 2d 632 (N.D. Tex. 2001), aff'd, Nos. 01-10463, 01-10773 (5th Cir. July 25, 2002); Society of Lloyd's v. Grace, 718 N.Y.S.2d 327 (N.Y. App. Div. 2000); and

(2) judgment is entered in favor of The Society of Lloyd's and against Raymond Rosenberg declaring that the March 11, 1998 judgment in the High Court of Justice, Queen's Bench Division, England against Raymond Rosenberg and in favor of The Society of Lloyd's in Society of Lloyd's v. Rosenberg, 1997 Folio No. 804, is enforceable in the same manner as the judgment of another state which is entitled to full faith and credit, in the
